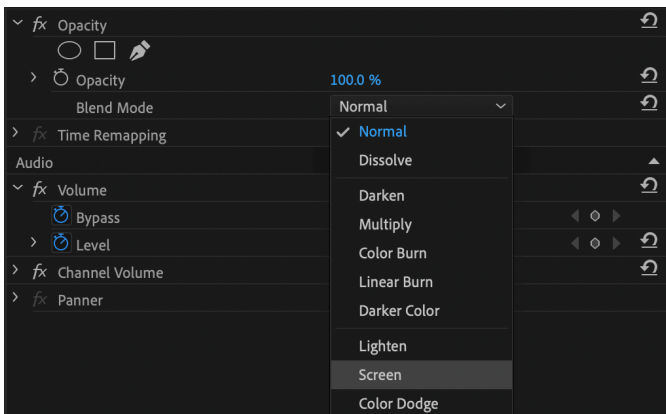


How to Use

(Based on Premiere Pro. Same method works for other software)

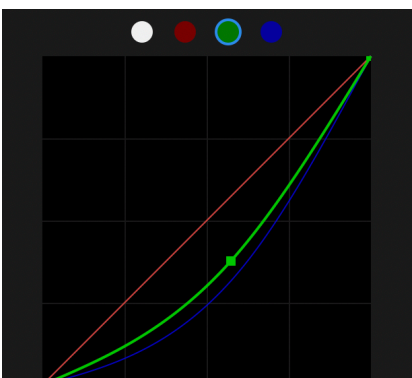
1. Open your Editing Program
2. Import the folder into the program
3. Drag a Flare Clip into your timeline, place it above your footage you want to have the Flare Clip on. Eg. If your video is on track 1 place the Flare Clip onto track 2.
4. Click on the Flare Clip and go to the effects panel.
5. Open up the toggle 'Opacity'.
6. Change the 'Blend Mode' to 'Screen'.



Changing the color of the flares

To change the color of the flares, there are 2 methods you can use.

1. Open up the 'Curves' effect. This effect will be available in all editing programs. Click on either Red, Green or Blue channel and click in the middle of the line. This will create a movable point. Once you create a point in the middle, then drag the line either to the top left or bottom right. You will then understand how this changes the color of the flares.
